

Nominating for an Event

Open the nominations page and you'll see a list of events — open for entries now, or coming soon. Tap an event to open its nomination form. You'll see the date, start time, format, entry fee, cart cost, and lunch details before you enter anything.

Three Ways to Nominate

- **Solo** — enter just your own details.
- **Join a Solo Player** — pick someone who's already put their name down on their own, and pair up with them.
- **New Pair** — enter your details and your partner's in one go.

If there's only one spot left, a pair won't fit. You can take the last spot solo, or join the reserve list as a solo or a pair.

What You'll Need to Enter

- First and last name
- Golfink number (10 digits)
- Contact number
- Cart preference — walking, your own cart, or a hire cart
- Lunch, if the event offers it
- A note for the organiser, if you need one (optional)

If the Event Is Full

You'll go straight onto the reserve list — there's nothing extra you need to do. The organiser will be in touch if a spot opens up.

Changing or Cancelling Your Booking

Find your name under Current Nominations on the event page and tap it. You'll be asked for your Golfink number to confirm it's you. From there you can:

- change your cart preference (and your note, if you're Player A)
- remove yourself from the event

Nominations can only be changed while they're open. Once the organiser closes an event, contact them directly to make changes.

Checking the Season Schedule

Tap Schedule at the top of the nominations page for the full year's fixtures. Games are colour-coded — green for Home Games, blue for Away Games, gold for Special Events, and orange for public holidays. Use the month links at the top to jump around.

The schedule is a season overview only — it isn't linked to nominations. To nominate for a specific away game, go back to the main nominations page.

Quick Tips

- Your Golfink number is how the system knows it's you when you come back to edit or cancel — keep it handy.
- Double-check your contact number so the organiser can reach you if something changes.
